### \* HOUSING

**Utilities, furnishings, kitchen amenities, and bedding included:** There are three housing properties the student will be assigned to. Property & roommate preference considered but not guaranteed. Must complete application upon receipt of job offer to receive employee housing placement.

\*1. **QUADS Housing Complex-** These are 4-bedroom, 2-bathroom apartments. Private bedroom (apartments separated by gender) rent is \$400/month + \$400 refundable deposit. All utilities are included in the cost of rent (+wifi, cable). Laundry facility located in walking distance. Furnished; full-size beds (bedding not provided), night stand, closet, living room furniture, dining table/chairs, silverware, dishware, dish drying rack, microwave, fridge.

\*2. **Bunk House room** - The Bunk House and 800 Corporate Building provide dormitory-style living accommodations. Each of these properties has shared bedrooms with two or three beds, communal living areas, men's/women's showers and coin-operated laundry facilities. All utilities, including television and internet, are included in the cost of rent. \$350/ month for a single Bunk House room.

\*3. **Bunk House shared** - The Bunk House and 800 Corporate Building provide dormitory-style living accommodations. Each of these properties has shared bedrooms with two or three beds, communal living areas, men's/women's showers and coin-operated laundry facilities. All utilities, including television and internet, are included in the cost of rent. \$175/ month for a shared Bunk House room.
